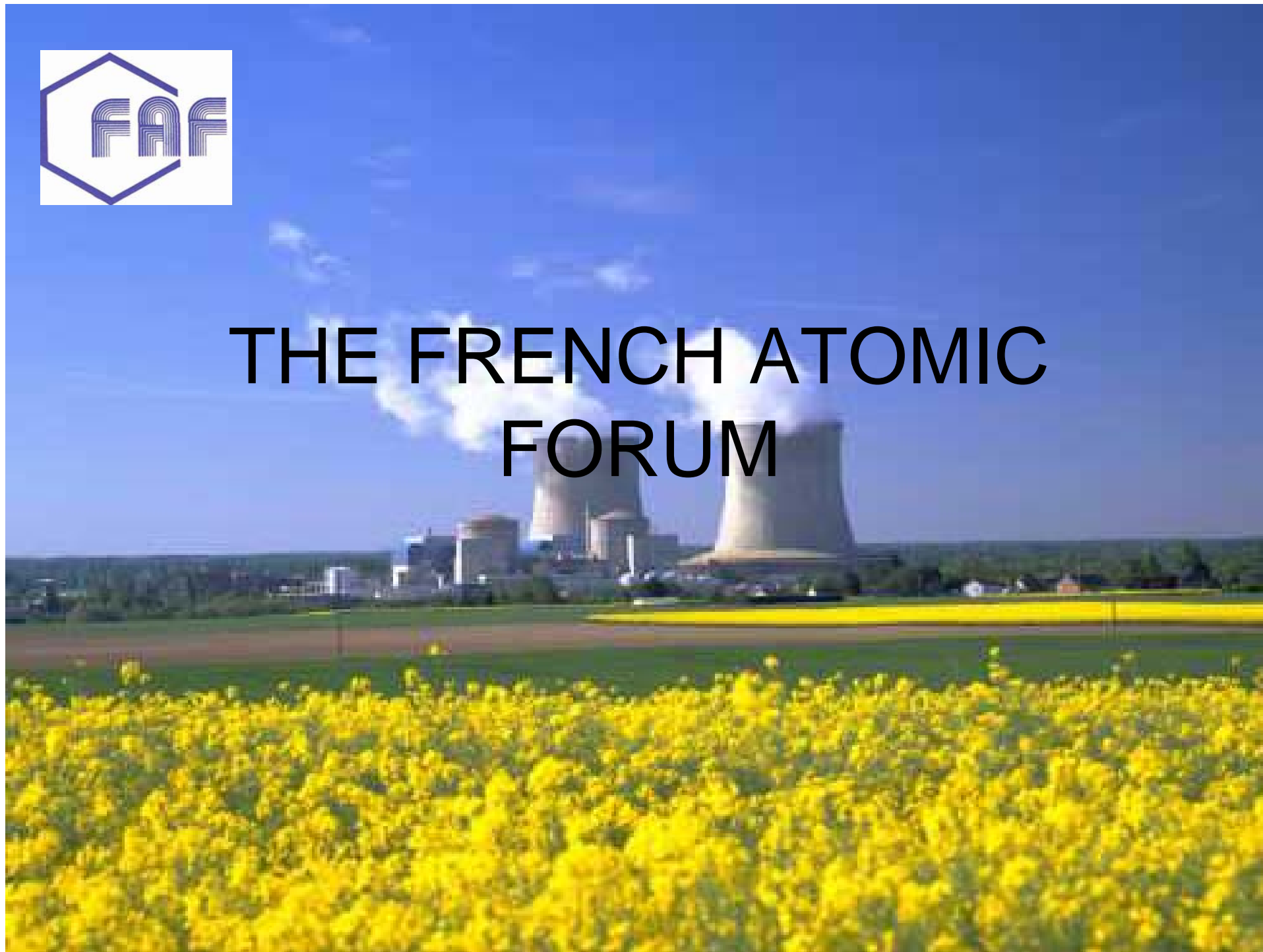




THE FRENCH ATOMIC FORUM





Introduction

- **French 1901 law Association established in 1975 by:**
 - CEA (the French Atomic Agency)
 - EDF (Electricité de France, the French National Utility)
 - GIIN (the French Nuclear Industry Association)
 - SFEN (the French Nuclear Energy Society)
- **Members :** All legal entities interested in scientific and technical matters relating to the nuclear field
- **Purpose:**
 - Strengthen the co-operation between all civil nuclear companies (Industry and Institutions)
 - Set up common positions for the Nuclear Industry Development
 - Implement actions towards international Associations. In particular, the FAF represents its members within the European Atomic Forum (FORATOM)



Bylaws and Constitution

- One President and one General Secretary
- A General Assembly and two Boards of Directors held every year
