(a) ORAL / POSTER PRESENTER

To ensure the availability of their full paper and/or poster in the conference publications, authors (oral and poster presenters) must register for either one day or the full meeting **by July 31 at the latest**.

If you are a student, you qualify for the student registration fee.

(b) STUDENT

A valid student card is required to confirm this status.

(c) PREFERENTIAL

For co-authors, committee members, session chairs, members of SFEN and Nuclear Societies partners of the conference

PAYMENT TERMS

After validation of the online registration form, an invoice (100% of the amount due) will be issued.

The total payment validates the registration.

On-line payment (credit card, PayPal) or off-line payment (bank transfer) are available.

REMINDER

Please note that accommodation is not included in your registration fee.

CANCELLATION POLICY

We are all aware of the continuing uncertainties caused by the Covid-19 crisis and of the difficulty in predicting their impact on our plans.

In order to give you a clear understanding of the conference arrangements and **ensure that all stakeholders** (speakers, sponsors, exhibitors, organisers, and service providers) can participate in a fulfilling event, we encourage you to read the associated cancellation policy.

Covid-19 and its consequences are no longer grounds for cancellation due to force majeure. Since the WHO declared the Covid-19 outbreak a worldwide pandemic over a year ago, its consequences are no longer considered to be unforeseeable or unexpected.

This applies to transport disruptions and cancellations, travel advice and restrictions, and other governmental measures (border closures, travel bans, lockdown rules, etc.).

Cancellation by the participant

Cancellation made before 31 July will be refunded, minus a €200 handling fee.

Cancellation made after 1 August will not be refunded, but a replacement participant not yet enrolled can register for free.

If a participant falls ill with Covid-19, a full refund will be made on submission of documents justifying this entitlement.

Cancellation by the organiser

SFEN will not be liable for a cancellation of the event due to force majeure (a), for lack of participants (b), or for a reason not of its doing.

It will not be liable either for the different implications for the participant (transport costs, accommodation costs, etc.).

Registrations will be fully refunded in cases (a) and (b).
